ITEM 4. CHANGES IN REGISTRANT'S CERTIFYING ACCOUNTANTS.

On September 10, 2002, Digital Power Corporation (the "Registrant") engaged the accounting firm of Ernst & Young, as its independent certifying accountants for the remainder of the fiscal year ending December 31, 2002, including preparation of the audit and Form 10-KSB for the fiscal year ended December 31, 2002.
