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Item 1.01 Entry into a Material Definitive Agreement

On February 14, 2008, we entered into an agreement with Acme Chemical Marketing, L.L.C. (Acme) to purchase the solvents we use to make our pentachlorophenol solutions. We made significant purchases of solvents from Acme in the last two fiscal years on open account, and Acme is now one of our two major solvent suppliers. Pricing of solvents under the agreement will fluctuate with an agreed market benchmark. The initial term of the agreement is through December 31, 2009. The agreement renews automatically for one year periods unless either party delivers written notice of non-renewal at least ninety days prior to the expiration date.
