On July 30, 2007, CSG Systems International, Inc. issued a press release announcing that it had reached a definitive agreement to acquire Prairie Voice Services, Inc., a privately-held provider of interactive messaging services headquartered in Omaha, Nebraska. The agreement provides that CSG will acquire Prairie Voice Systems, Inc. for approximately \$39 million in cash (net of cash acquired), to be paid upon closing of the transaction which is currently anticipated to be in mid-August 2007, subject to the satisfaction of customary closing conditions. In addition, the merger agreement provides for contingent payments of up to \$6 million through the end of 2009 upon achievement of certain predetermined operating criteria. A copy of such press release is attached to this Form 8-K as Exhibit 99.1 and is incorporated into this section by reference.
