  - (1) The price reported in column 4 is a weighted average price. The shares were sold in multiple transactions in prices ranging from \$32.04 to \$32.11, inclusive. The reporting person undertakes to provide to Johnson Controls, any security holder of Johnson Controls, or the staff of the Securities and Exchange Commission, upon request, full information regarding the number of shares sold at each separate price within the range set forth in footnote (1) of this Form 4.
  - (2) The number of underlying securities is based on the stock fund balance on February 14, 2013. The actual number of shares issuable upon the distribution date is not determinable since the stock fund is a unitized account consisting of 96% company stock and 4% money market fund. The stock account balance reflected in this report is based on a February 14, 2013, stock fund price of \$31.83 per share.
  - (3) Each share of phantom stock is the economic equivalent of one share of Johnson Controls common stock.
  - (4) The phantom stock units were accrued under the Johnson Controls Retirement Restoration Plan and are to be settled 100% in cash upon the reporting person's termination of employment with the company.
  - (5) The balance includes 268,384 phantom stock units acquired through dividend reinvestment on December 28, 2012 at \$30.11 per phantom stock unit.
  - (6)

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The phantom stock units were accrued under the Johnson Controls Annual Incentive Plan and are to be settled 100% in cash upon the reporting person's retirement.

- (7) The balance includes 19,284 phantom stock units acquired through dividend reinvestment on December 28, 2012 at \$30.11 per phantom stock unit.
- (8) The phantom stock units were accrued under the Johnson Controls Long-Term Incentive Plan and are to be settled 100% in cash upon the reporting person's retirement.
- (9) The balance includes 604.61 phantom stock units acquired through dividend reinvestment on December 28, 2012 at \$30.11 per phantom stock unit.
- (10) The restricted stock units accrue under the Johnson Controls Restricted Stock Plan. The balance includes phantom stock and dividend equivalent units that settle 100% in cash and relate to restricted stock awards.
- (11) The balance includes 1,366.476 phantom stock units acquired through dividend reinvestment on December 28, 2012 at \$30.11 per phantom stock unit.
- (12) Fifty percent of the options become exercisable two years after the grant date; the remaining 50%, three years after grant date.
