- Consists of a grant of restricted stock units. Each restricted stock unit represents the right to receive, upon vesting, one share of common
- (1) stock. These restricted stock units will vest over three years, with one-third vesting on March 4, 2017; one-third vesting on March 4, 2018; and the remaining one-third vesting on March 4, 2019, assuming continued employment through the applicable vest date.

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This transaction was a broker-assisted sale of shares of common stock to satisfy the withholding tax liability incurred upon the vesting of restricted stock units, as mandated by the Issuer's election under its equity incentive plan documents, and does not represent a discretionary trade by the reporting person.

- (3) The reported price in Column 4 is a weighted average price. These shares were sold in multiple transactions at prices ranging from \$27.93 to \$28.32 per share, inclusive. - (4) Amount includes 8,557 shares of common stock, 3,415 restricted stock units and 6,646 performance share awards. Each restricted stock unit and performance share award represent the right to receive, upon vesting, one share of common stock. In addition to the shares underlying the restricted stock units described in footnote 1 above, the remaining 814 restricted stock units will vest on March 4, 2017, assuming continued employment through such date. The performance share awards will vest over two years, with one-half vesting on March 11, 2017 and the remaining one-half vesting on March 11, 2018, assuming continued employment through such dates.
