GOL Announces Traffic Statistics for January 2006

São Paulo, February 6, 2006 GOL Linhas Aéreas Inteligentes (NYSE: GOL and Bovespa: GOLL4), Brazil's low fare, low cost airline, today released preliminary passenger statistics for the month of January 2006. System-wide passenger traffic (RPK) increased 53%, while capacity (ASK) increased 60% y-o-y. GOL's system load factor for the month of January 2006 was 73%.

Domestic passenger traffic (RPK) for January increased 51%, while capacity (ASK) increased 59%. GOL's domestic load factor for the month of January 2006 was 73%.

International passenger traffic (RPK) for January increased 80%, while capacity (ASK) increased 74%. International load factor for the month of January 2006 was 68%.

Yield per passenger kilometer decreased by approximately 4% y-o-y, due principally to a 5% increase in average stage length.

- (3) *Load factor* represents the percentage of aircraft seating capacity that is actually utilized (calculated by dividing revenue passenger kilometers by available seat kilometers).
