- (1) the distribution date is not determinable since the stock fund is a unitized account consisting of 96% company stock and 4% money market fund. The stock account balance reflected in this report is based on an October 2, 2012, stock fund price of \$27.55 per share.
 - (2) Fifty percent of the options become exercisable two years after the grant date; the remaining 50%, three years after grant date.
 - (3) Each unit of phantom stock is the economic equivalent of one share of Johnson Controls common stock.
 - (4) The phantom stock units accrue under the Johnson Controls Retirement Restoration Plan and are to be settled 100% in cash upon the reporting person's termination of employment with the company.
 - (5) The phantom stock units accrue under the Johnson Controls Long-Term Incentive Plan and are to be settled 100% in cash upon the reporting person's termination of employment with the company.
 - (6) The restricted stock units accrue under the Johnson Controls Restricted Stock Plan. The balance includes phantom stock and dividend equivalent units that settle 100% in cash and relate to restricted stock awards.
